Garden Grove, CA. OCVCD Names New District Manager. The Orange County Vector Control District (OCVCD) is pleased to announce the hiring of a new District Manager. Michael Hearst was selected to be the new District Manager at the Board of Trustees meeting on Thursday August 26, 2010. The vote was: 26 Ayes, 4 Noes, 1 Abstained, and 4 Absent.

Before being named the District Manager of OCVCD, Mr. Hearst had served as Interim District Manager since April of 2010. Mr. Hearst has been working with the District since 1999, both at OCVCD and for the Orange County Fire Ant Authority.

"I am very proud to be the new District Manager. The District will continue to provide the people of Orange County the highest level of protection from vectors and vector-borne disease.
